Lesson 1: Diagnostic and course planning

- Brief introduction to the ISLPR format and expectations
- Identification of strengths and priority areas
- Explanation of effective strategies for preparation

Lesson 2: Speaking foundations

- Building fluency and confidence in personal and professional topics
- Using academic/technical vocabulary appropriately
- Giving longer answers with clear organisation
- Strategies for hesitation, repair, and clarification

Lesson 3: Listening foundations

- Listening for gist and key details
- Introduction to note-taking methods
- Recognising signposting and shifts in topic

Lesson 4: Reading foundations

- Reading for main ideas, supporting details, and viewpoint
- Strategies for dealing with unfamiliar vocabulary
- Moving from comprehension to spoken response

Lesson 5: Writing foundations

- Understanding likely writing purposes, audience, and tone
- Planning and organising a clear response
- Focus on sentence control and paragraphing

Lesson 6: Speaking extension

- More complex speaking tasks based on issues, opinions, or workplace contexts
- Developing reasons, examples, and comparisons
- Focus on grammar and vocabulary in spoken performance

Lesson 7: Listening and discussion extension

- Longer listening texts and more demanding follow-up discussion
- Summarising spoken information from notes

- Focus on accuracy and completeness when reporting ideas

Lesson 8: Reading to speaking extension

- More challenging texts with discussion and interpretation
- Talking about purpose, attitude, implications, and key ideas
- Linking reading input to broader discussion

Lesson 9: Writing under test conditions

- Timed or semi-timed writing practice
- Focus on control, organisation, and appropriateness
- Error correction

Lesson 10: Mock practice and final action plan

- Short mock tasks or integrated practice across key skills
- Final feedback
- Review of strategies for the test day
- Personalised study plan for continued preparation
